The Budapest Contemporary Dance Academy announces an open call for its student in regards student mobility.

The goal is to give an opportunity of gaining new experiences in the educational system, the language and the culture of a foreign higher education institution and country. The student mobility is supposed to maintain the student's on-going studies and to help improving his/her personal skills.

Eligibility: current students of BCDA, min. 2 finished semesters.

Potential countries of destination: EU member countries, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.

Place of student mobility: Higher education institutions holding an „Erasmus Charter for Higher Education” in any countries listed above.

Duration of student mobility: minimum 3, maximum 12 months. A student can get financial support for max. 12 months (student mobility + traineeship) throughout his/her studies on each degree level.

Period: continuous

An application could be submitted by filling in an application form and attaching the required documents listed there.

Deadline for submission: it could be handed in anytime.

Mode of submission: via mail to budapest@dance.org.hu, indicating 'Erasmus open call' as the letter's subject.

Process of evaluation: The Rector of the BCDA has the right to make a decision of the application by taking into account the opinions of the Erasmus Committee (international coordinator, one student, one teacher). Criteria: 1st The professional preparedness of the applicant. 2nd The probable success of studying/working in the chosen foreign environment. 3rd The quality and the feasibility of the professional work plan. 4th Available financial budget.

Date of results: Until the 15th of the next month after submission.

Expected amount of financial support: 400-500 €/month depending on the destination (see the detailed document attached); 100 €/month extra support for underprivileged students is available upon a separate application procedure.

Advisory and assistance service: By appointment you can have resort consulting about the content and the format of your future application.
