BUDAPEST CONTEMPORARY DANCE ACADEMY STUDENT MOBILITY OPEN CALL

The Budapest Contemporary Dance Academy announces an open call for its student in regard to student mobility.

The goal is to give an opportunity of gaining new experiences in the educational system, the language and the culture of a foreign higher education institution and country. Student mobility is supposed to maintain the student's ongoing studies and to help improve his/her personal skills.

Eligibility: current students of BCDA.

Potential countries of destination: EU member countries, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Serbia, Republic of North Macedonia [and other partner countries](#).

Place of student mobility: Higher education institutions hold an „Erasmus Charter for Higher Education” in any countries listed above.

Duration of student mobility: minimum 2, maximum 12 months. A student can get financial support for max. 12 months (student mobility + traineeship) throughout his/her studies on each degree level.

Period: Continuous

An application could be submitted by filling in an application form and attaching the required documents listed there.

Deadline for submission: it could be handed in anytime.

Mode of submission: By filling in the [online application form](#).

Process of evaluation: The Rector of the BCDA has the right to decide on the application by considering the opinions of the Erasmus Committee (international coordinator, one student, and one teacher). Criteria: 1st The professional preparedness of the applicant. 2nd The probable success of studying/working in the chosen foreign environment. 3rd The quality and the feasibility of the professional work plan. 4th Available financial budget.

Date of results: Until the 15th of the next month after submission.

The expected amount of financial support: 540-700 €/month depending on the destination. 250 €/month of extra social support for underprivileged students is available upon a separate application procedure.

Advisory and assistance service: By appointment, you can have resort consulting about the content and the format of your future application.
