E-mail

Elaboration of one or two of the chosen topics

- Title(s) / Subtitle(s)
- Proposed consultant(s) (2-3-4 names)
- One chapter (introduction), around 1-2 pages
- Detailed table of contents
- List and definition of key notions
- Bibliography

Advices:

1. Regarding bibliography in addition to the internet go to library, ask experts for advice as well!
2. The texts you write on this stage will not necessarily be part of your final thesis. You can take them as starting points.
3. Writing thesis is a creative work. Similar to your studio work. A lot of thoughts come up, you try (write) a lot, and later you have to choose from them. It is normal, that you can not write a text ready-for-print regarding style, structure and thoughts.

Feedbacks, comments on the selected one or two topics

Homework for this seminar:

- read at least 2 other theses and have an opinion to share
- have and start to read 2-3 items from you own bibliography
- have a list (2-3 names) for possible consultant

Make corrections, additions if needed, and then send to Petra or Kinga for approval.

Once you have reached this stage BCDA asks a consultant to work with you. And you can start working with your consultant. Consultation may happen personally, via e-mail, skype... It is up to you and the consultant how to organise it.

If you have the approved topic and the consultant you can and you have to apply 'officially' for the defence of thesis. See the document titled 'BCDA thesis application form'.

E-mail

Text of at least one chapter. 3-5-10 pages, structured, 'ready' text with clear references. Not sketch! Consultation with the consultant had to have happened.
